





While technology is revolutionizing nursing, it can not fully replace the crucial element of psychological care.

Here is a breakdown of why !

### **Efficiency and Accuracy**

□ Technology excels at tasks like monitoring vial signs, administering medication, and maintaining electronic health records, reducing human errors, and freeing up nurses' time

□ Remote patients monitoring allows for continuous tracking of patients' health, and enabling early interventions











## **Accessibility and Communication**

- □ Telehealth platforms that improves access to care, especially for those in remote areas
- □ Technology facilitates communication between healthcare providers and patients









While nursing technology is rapidly advancing and Can significantly enhance health care delivery, it cannot fully replace the essential elements of psychological care.









## **Empathy and Compassion**



- □ Psychological care heavily relies of empathy, the ability to understand and sharing the feeling of another.
- □ Technology even with advanced A cannot replicate the genuine emotional connection and compassionate response that a human care provides.
- □ Patients experiencing psychological distress often need reassurance, comfort, and a sense of being understood which are fundamental human qualities









### **Nuanced Communication**



- □ Psychological care involves complex communication including interpreting nonverbal cues, understanding emotional shift and adapting to individual needs.
- □ While technology can analyse data and recognize patterns, it struggles to grasp especially in emotionally charged situations.









## **Ethical Decision Making and Judgement**



- Psychological care often involves complex ethical dilemmas and requires sound judgement.
- □ Technology even with sophisticated algorithm, cannot fully account for the subjective nature of human experience and ethical consideration that arise in psychological care.
- □ Human caregivers can navigate these complexities by considering individual values, cultural factors, and the patients' unique circumstances.









## The therapeutic relationship



- □ A strong therapeutic relationship is essential for effective psychological care.
- □ The relationship is bult on trust, support and a sense of safety which is difficult to establish with technology









### In essence

• Technology can be powerful tool in nursing, but it should be used to augment, rather than substitute the essential human element of psychological care.








